Dr Chih-Hung Kuo is a cataract, glaucoma, eyelids and tear duct surgeon. He also treats conditions affecting the macula such as age related macular degeneration and diabetes.

He studied medicine at the University of New South Wales and completed his prevocational training at the Royal Prince Alfred Hospital in Sydney.

Dr Kuo began his ophthalmology training at the Sydney Eye Hospital.

He spent two further fellowship years at the Concord Repatriation Hospital in Sydney and Royal

Devon and Exeter Hospital in the United Kingdom, subspecializing in complex glaucoma and oculoplastic.

He is a fellow of the Royal Australian and New Zealand College of Ophthalmologists.

Dr Kuo is appointed as a consultant eye surgeon at the Gold Coast University Hospital, supervising and training next generation of ophthalmologists.

Dr Kuo also published over ten articles in peer-review journals, including the New England Journal of Medicine and the Lancet.
